BHI reply on the queries of PSE dated October 17, 2018
Information Requested
<p>Pleased to to furnish you our response on your queries dated today as follows:</p> <p>1. Update on Fridays Boracay Beach Resort's ("Fridays Boracay") compliance with the clearances from the relevant government agencies;</p> <p>BHI Response: Atty. Rama Pascua of the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) lawyer said on October 16, 2018 that there is a new memorandum circular from Secretary Cimatú that fifty (50) rooms above requires 100% completion of the Sewerage Treatment Plant (STP) .</p> <p>Atty. Pascua will inform the inspection team to inspect and issue Certificate of Compliance (COC) immediately to Friday's Boracay Beach Resort once the STP is completed.</p> <p>Friday's Boracay Beach Resort's completion of the STP construction timeline this Friday, October 19, 2018. (note: Friday's Boracay Beach Resort STP Contract with Boracay Tubi System (BTS) was entered into Agreement last August 14, 2018.)</p> <p>2. Reason for the non-accreditation by the Department of Tourism of Fridays Boracay;</p> <p>BHI Response On October 13, 2018 the schedule inspection of Friday's Resort Boracay was postponed due to new DOT ruling. For DOT accreditation we were informed of the new ruling imposed by the DOT Region that DOT Region will inspect resorts once DENR COC is duly accomplished/secured. The Resort is expecting the release of DENR COC on October 20, 2018.</p> <p>3. Timetable for the re-opening of Fridays Boracay;</p> <p>BHI Response: Friday's Boracay Beach Resort expects for its re-opening on October 26, 2018. Should there be delays, because of the possible postponements in the inspection of the EMB will be expected to be a week delay.</p>

Timeline of STP 100 % completion this coming Friday, October 19, 2018 and EMB Inspection Team to inspect and will then issue the COC.

4. Effects on the Company's operations, business and financial condition of the nonaccreditation of Fridays Boracay;

BHI Response:

The nonaccreditation of Friday's Boracay is a pessimistic scenario which is less likely to happen.

No revenue loss if Friday's opens during time of official Boracay Island reopening date of October 26, 2018. There is though slight opportunity lost in pre-bookings for not being able to show our permits prior to the official date, but this is weighed against gaining higher room prices on the spot after opening due to restricted room supply situation.

5. Any other relevant information.

BHI Response

Friday's resort will reap financially the effects of the Boracay Island rehabilitation. With limited number of rooms in the area, Boracay Beach Resorts will charge in higher room rates for tourists due to scarcity of rooms available for sale. The impact of the new Boracay due to its rehabilitation will result in the clean beaches, clear waters, fresh air, and wide open spaces which will further boost the improved tourism business activities in the island.
